Terms of the application

1. To apply:

- a. You must be a current, fully paid-up, student member of OUGC.
- b. You must be in full time study at the University of Oxford or Oxford Brookes University.
- c. You must not have 'substantial' flying experience prior to joining OUGC. See restrictions.
- d. You must have completed a minimum of 30 qualifying flights at your own expense, but not started flying solo yet.
- d. You must scan/photograph your logbook record and attach it to the application.

2. The bursary:

- a. Covers launches and flights with an instructor only. It cannot form part of membership fees, solo flights, travel expenses etc.
- b. Expires when the limit of £150 is reached, when the applicant achieves Solo Endorsement, or after one calendar year.
- c. Will be paid retrospectively and directly to the Windrushers Gliding Club flying accounts.
- d. Covers training flights conducted at Bicester Gliding Centre by the Windrushers Gliding Club.
- e. Can cover flights at other clubs and airfields if prior arrangements are made with OUGC Treasurer.

3. Restrictions:

- a. Maximum time limit of the bursary is one calendar year.
- b. Only one application may be submitted per person.
- c. The bursary is aimed at new pilots. If you have previous flying experience, contact membership@ougc.org. Decisions are made on a case-by-case basis.
- d. Applicant's details are subject to verification.
- e. This application is accepted in good faith and does **not** form a contract, in part or implied, between the applicant and OUGC.
- f. OUGC reserves the right to cancel the scheme without notice.
